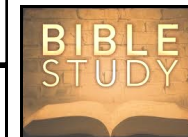

All ladies are invited and encouraged to attend the WH&FM meeting on March 1st at 7:00 p.m. Refreshments will be served as we discuss upcoming activities.

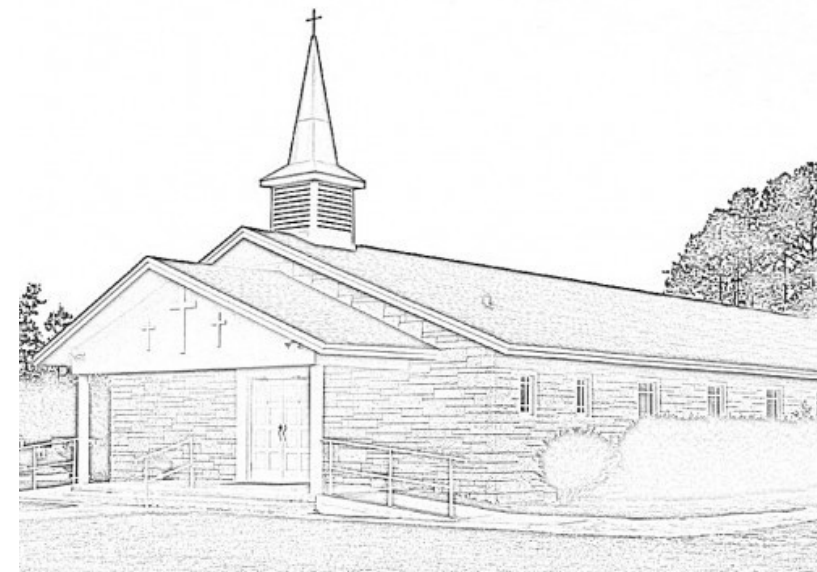
